The contest is open to children, adults age 55 and older, and disabled or special needs residents of our affordable housing communities. PAHMA, along with many other AHMAs across the country submit entries for this national contest. From these entries, 13 are chosen to appear in the NAHMA calendar. National prizes range from \$100 for Honorable Mention to the Grand Prize of \$2,500 and a trip to Washington, DC. (only children are eligible for the Grand Prize). In addition, each local winner is awarded \$100 from PAHMA.

ALL CONTESTANTS SUBMITTING ARTWORK MUST RESIDE IN A COMMUNITY THAT IS A CURRENT MEMBER OF PAHMA.

Will YOU bring home the next winner? We encourage property owners and managers to promote the contest in your communities and submit the artwork to PAHMA. Consider having a Community Art Contest to celebrate your artists!

ENTRY DATE EXTENDED...SUBMIT A PHOTO OF THE ORIGINAL ARTWORK BY MAY 22nd:

Entries must be submitted to INFO@PAHMA.ORG no later than Friday, May 22, 2020. The final round of local judging of all qualified artwork will occur electronically on Thursday, May 28th. The winning artists and Property Managers will be notified and original artwork will then need to be mailed to PAHMA for receipt no later than June 5th for the national judging. PAHMA will award \$100 to each artist whose entry is selected to advance to the national level, AND a free Registration to the Property Manager for one staff person to attend our 2021 Fall Conference.

All entries must follow the national contest rules. Download the complete contest rules with required forms at <u>CONTEST RULES & FORMS</u>. Only entries sent to PAHMA will be accepted.
